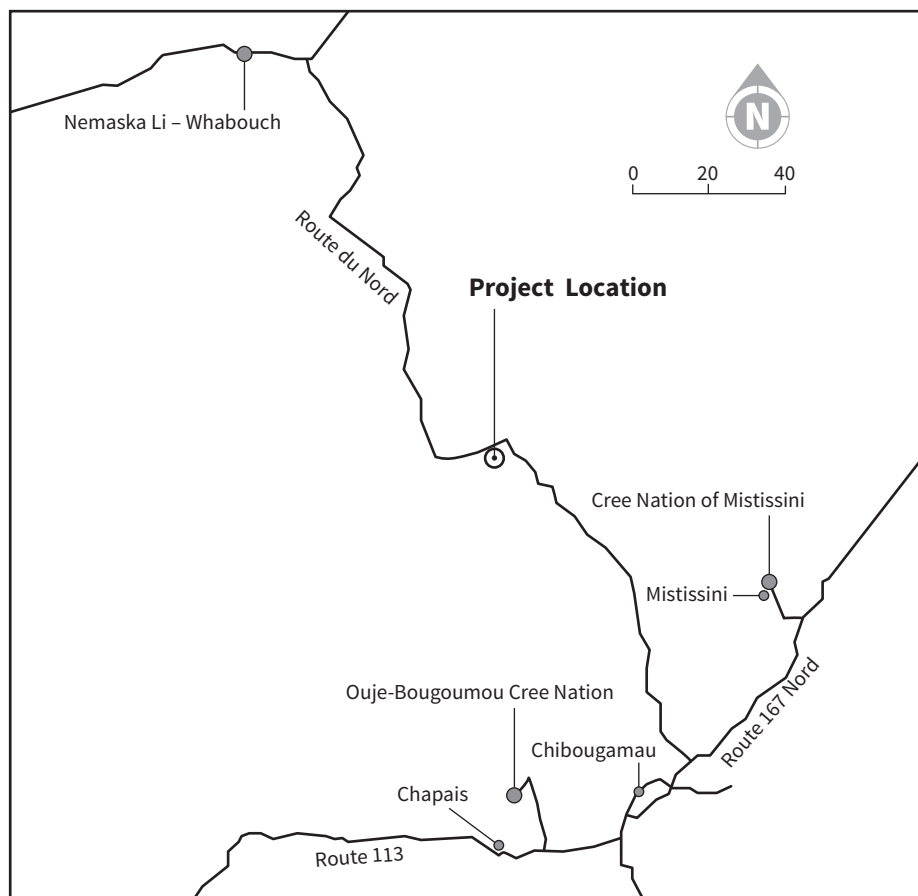


Notice of Commencement of an Environmental Impact Study and Notice of Public Information Sessions

Guo Ao Lithium Ltd./Neotec Lithium (Quebec) is proposing to construct and operate the Moblan Lithium Project (lithium mine and concentrator) located approximately 100 km north-northwest of Chibougamau, in northern Quebec, on the territory governed by the James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement. The Project is proposed to be located on Category III lands. The map below identifies the location of the proposed development.



The proposed Project is subject to the Environmental Impact Study and Review Process in accordance with Chapter II of the *Environmental Quality Act* as well as specific provisions applicable to Baie-James and Nord-du-Quebec in accordance with the James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement requiring the active participation of the Cree Nation in protecting the rights and guarantees granted to them under the Agreement.

Hatch Ltd. has been retained to undertake the environmental assessment process for the Project.
